PROGRAM REPORT

Program Overview

Carmel Youth Assistance Program (CYAP) serves as an early intervention advocate for youth ages 3-17 who are facing challenging life circumstances. We take a holistic approach to coordinate our community's vast array of talents, services and resources to help youth and empower parents and caregivers.

One of the many charges of CYAP is to provide tutoring supports for at-risk students. As the cost for one-on-one tutoring services continue to rise, CYAP recognized the need to create a program to provide tutoring services to low-income families. As research began on how to most effectively fill this gap in services, CYAP learned students who struggle academically experience greater learning loss during the summer months. In turn, this results in a more difficult start to the school year, increased gaps in learning as students age, and lower self-confidence.

As a result, the Summer Bridge Tutoring Program began in 2021 and graduated our fourth cohort of students in August 2025. The Summer Bridge program partners with Carmel Clay Schools to select students who both need academic support over the summer and are on the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. CYAP recruits and trains teachers and tutors to work with these youth in the areas of reading and math.

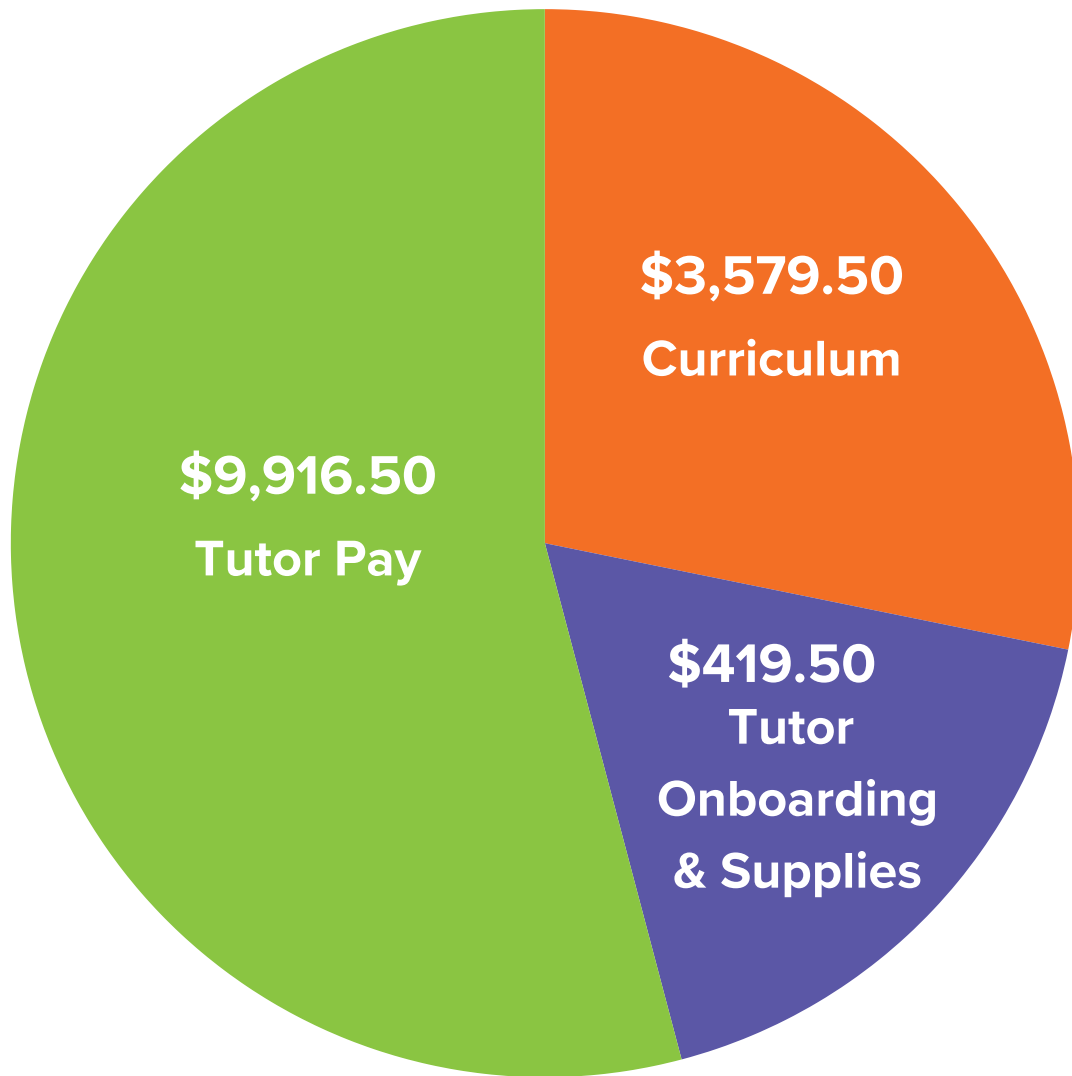

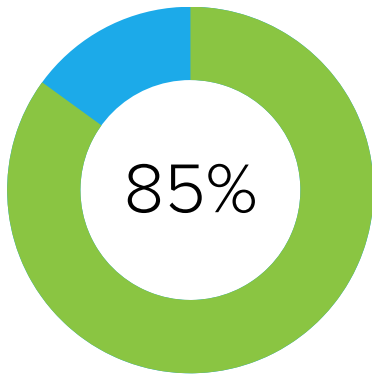

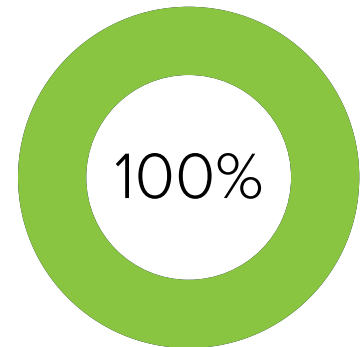

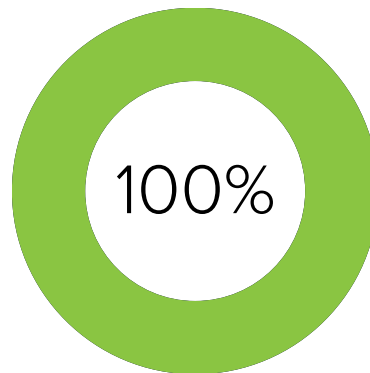

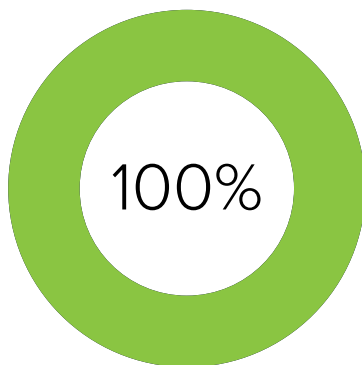
Percent of families who cited cost of service as the #1 barrier to access tutoring for their child



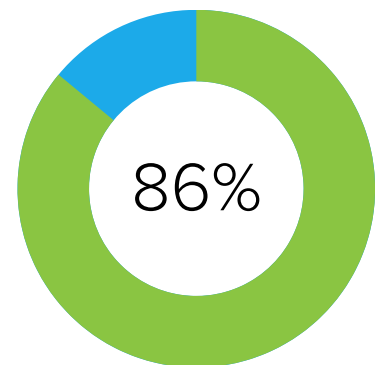
Percent of parents who felt their child's skills in reading and/or math progressed during the summer tutoring program



Percent of parents felt like their child's tutor was a good match



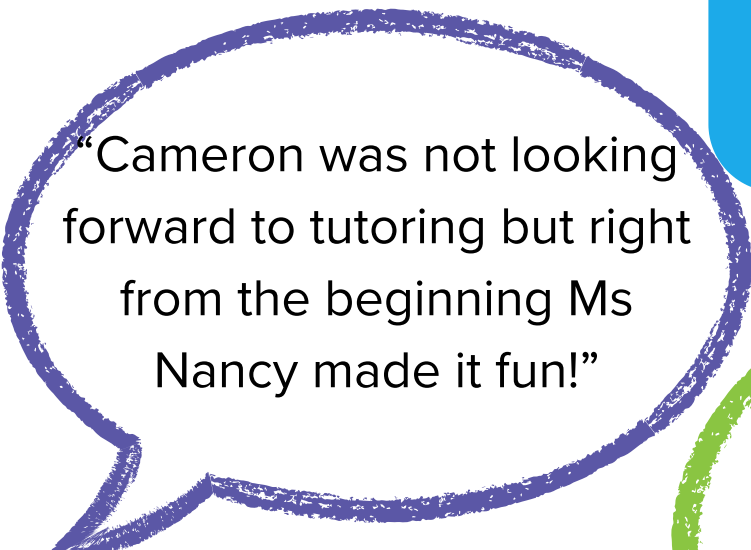
Percent of parents who want their child to participate in the program again in 2026

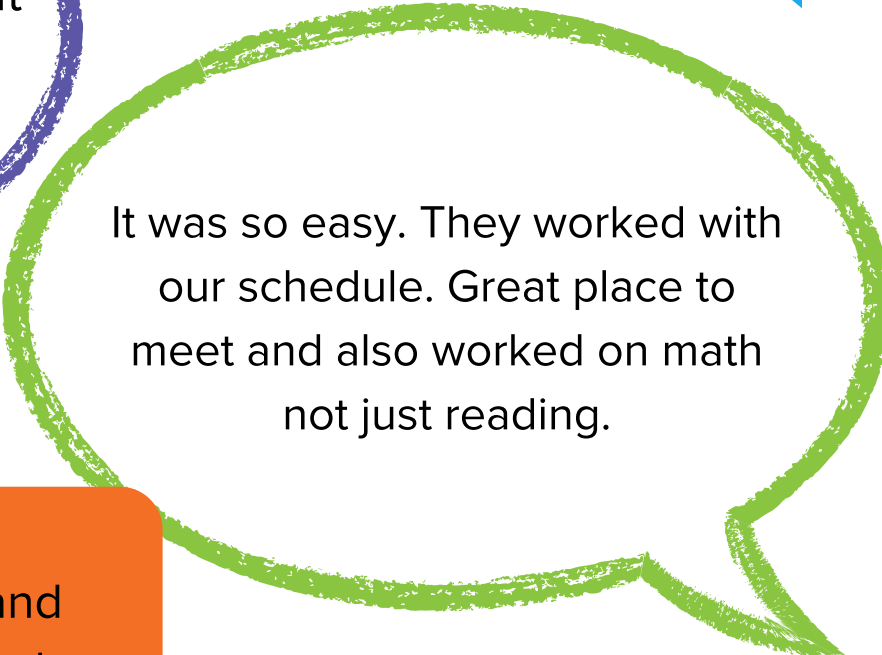
As a parent, what was your favorite part of the Summer Bridge tutoring program?



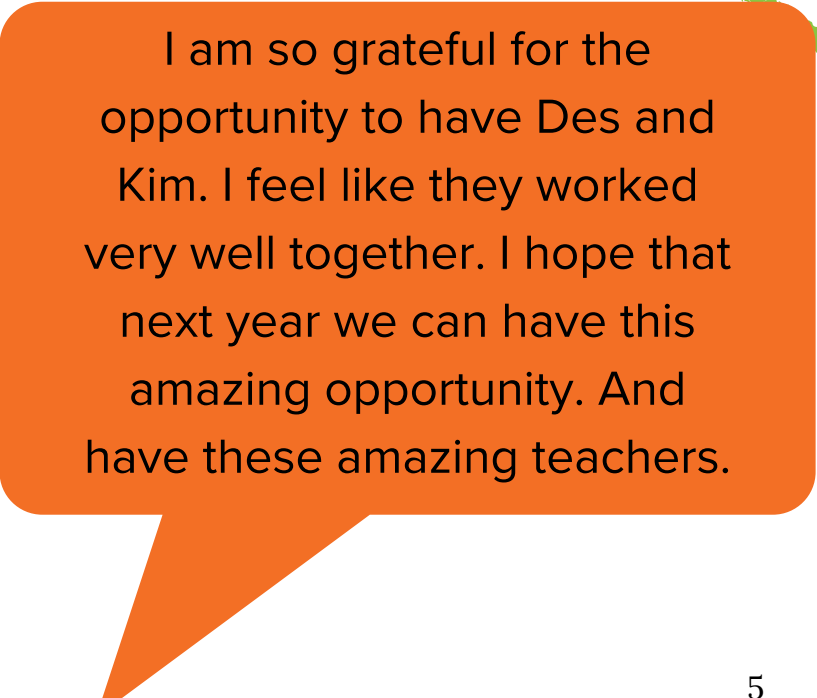
